JR VARSITY

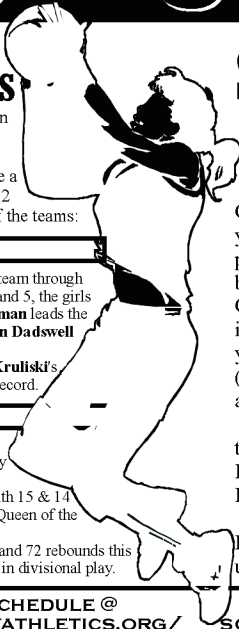
